Pittsburgh International Race Complex is located in Big Beaver Borough, near Wampum, Pennsylvania. Located on PA Rt. 18, at the Beaver Valley exit 13, Pitt Race is accessible from all major highways, including I-79, I-376, and I-80.

Lodging and Accommodations

For visitors requiring overnight accommodations, there are a number of hotel/motel properties within a convenient distance of Pitt Race.

Garages and Paddock Facilities

As a full-service motorsports complex, Pitt Race has an extensive trackside paddock area for vehicle staging, preparation, and team support. Electrical service is available through advanced booking by calling Pitt Race at (724)-535-1000.

Eight garage bays are available for rental adjacent to the North Track with transporter parking access. Another eight garage bays are available for rental under the Event Center with limited adjacent parking for trailers and transports. All bays are equipped with roll-up doors and electrical service to be used inside the bay only.

Please note that Pitt Race does not provide a sanitary dump or water facilities for RVs or transports.

Pittsburgh International Race Complex is located in Big Beaver Borough, near Wampum, PA. Located on PA Rt 18, approximately 2.3 miles north of the PA Turnpike (I-76) Exit 13 (Beaver Valley), our location is accessible from all major highways, including I-79, I-376, and I-80.

Safety Policies

The staff and management at Pitt Race endeavor to create a fun and safe place for visitors and participants alike. Our facility is designed with your safety in mind, but this is a high-performance, high-speed venue. We want you to have fun and return again so we ask that all visitors and racers adhere to the following rules:

Facility Rules and Regulations:

- Waiver must be signed by each individual before entering the premises.
- Appropriate wristbands must be worn at all times.
- Wood or suitable material must be used on all paved surfaces under all trailer jacks, tongues, and stands to prevent damage.
- All fluid spills must be reported so that absorbent material can be applied.
- Dispose of all motor oil, brake fluid, and antifreeze must be disposed of in marked containers in designated areas only.
- All tires, scrap metal (including broken canopies), and any other vehicle parts must be taken with you. Pitt Race will not dispose of this material at the track.
- All pets must be leashed at all time and all pet waste must be bagged and disposed of appropriately.
- your convenience, helmets are available for rent in the Pitt Stop Pro Shop.
- Anyone operating a motorized vehicle on site, including paddocks, must have a valid drivers license. This includes operation of motor scooters, ATVs, motorcycles, and golf carts. Motorized vehicles may be used only for transport around the facility. NO jumping, speeding, or any other activity Pitt Race may deem dangerous or threatening to other facility users will be permitted.
- Approved helmets must be worn for any on-track activity in excess of 45 mph – no exceptions. For Failure to adhere to any of these rules is ground for removal from the facility. No fireworks, firearms, or weapons of any kind at any times.
- No drone usage.
- Please help us keep the grounds clean by disposing of all refuse in trash containers, conveniently located throughout the facility.
- Please be considerate of others by avoiding loud music and respecting “quiet hours” from 8 pm to 8 am.
- For safety, please observe the posted 10 mph speed limit in all paddocks and parking areas.
- No open campfires. Grills and elevated, contained fire pits are permitted if more than 50 ft from the fuel farm.
- No alcohol during hours of operation.
- No illegal drugs.
- Failure to adhere to any of these rules is grounds for removal from the facility.

Frequently Asked Questions

Here are some of the most commonly asked questions about Pitt Race and our programs. If you have a question that is not answered below, please contact us with your inquiry via info@PittRace.com or call (724)-535-1000.

What is the Cancellation Policy? (Pitt Race events- PDE, Test & Tune, Car Control, etc.)

Cancellations 48 hours prior to an event will be refunded. Cancellations between 48 and 24 hours prior to an event will be credited toward a future Pitt Race event. Cancellations on the day of a Pitt Race Event or a no shows will not be offered refunds.

What Waivers are required?

Everyone entering the gate must sign a waiver. Visitors under 18 years of age must sign a minor waiver along with a guardian.

Is Photography allowed?

Commercial photography and video is permitted at Pitt Race only after signing the Pitt Race media waiver. The Pitt Race Media waiver is available at the office or by contacting the marketing department at info@PittRace.com or at (724-535-1000) Personal photography is encouraged and permitted from all spectating areas on the facility. At no time are spectators permitted inside fencing, on any race surface, pit lane, or timing and scoring or in start stand tower for photography.

What days and times is the track open?

Track operations vary by season and schedule

Office (Year Round): 8 am – 5 pm

Karting (Seasonal): Noon - Dark for rentals

Race Practice

Mon -Thurs: Noon – Dark

Fri - Sun: 8 am – Noon

North, South, Full Track and VDA: Per schedule, event, or appointment.

Are there spectator fees?

We welcome all enthusiasts. There are no gate fees for most Pitt Race Events. There is a \$5 spectating fee for drifting events. Events such as MotoAmerica, Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix, and other major race events reserve the right to charge a ticketing fee at their discretion. Please contact the sanctioning body of the event you plan to attend to confirm any gate or ticketing fees.

Is on-site camping available?

Pitt Race has limited camping availability. Race teams are permitted to park and stay on-site provided the sanctioning body has booked overnight security for that particular event. Please contact Pitt Race for camping information during your chosen event.

Are there showers on-site?

Showers are available in the restrooms at the Event Center, North Track garages, and Karting tower.

Are campfires permitted?

Open campfires are not permitted. Grills and contained, elevated fire pits are permitted at least 50 ft away from the fuel farm.

Are there public phones available? WiFi?

There are no coin operated, public phones available at Pitt Race. Cellular service is widely available and a public WiFi network is provided near all track side buildings.

How can I buy track gift cards?

You can obtain gift cards on site in the Main Office or by calling (724)-535-1000 to place an order. We accept all major credit cards.

Are there ATM machines available?

There are no ATM machines on site at Pitt Race. ATMs are accessible at Al's Corner Market, located 0.7 miles from the track. We do accept cash, checks, and all major credit cards on site.

Is the Event Center available for rent? Can I rent the North Track, South Track, Skid Pad, or Wilson Circuit for an event?

Our Event Center – located on a bluff overlooking the North Track – is available for private functions. For more information, please contact our sales department to make arrangement or to check pricing and availability by calling (724)-535-1000.

The racing and driving surfaces may be rented for special events by contacting our sales manager, Dave Hois at (724)-535-1000.

Who should I contact if I encounter a problem?

During events, our personnel will be available at the Pitt Stop Pro Shop or in an official Pitt Race vehicle in the paddocks.

Can I ride my bicycle at the track?

Bicycles are permitted, but Pitt Race retains the right to confiscate any bicycle if it is being ridden in an unsafe manner or used for recreational, not transportation, purposes.

Can I bring my ATV, mini-bike, golf cart, or dirt bike?

Anyone operating a motorized vehicle on site, including paddocks, must have a valid drivers license. This includes operation of motor scooters, ATVs, motorcycles, and golf carts. Motorized vehicles may be used only for transport around the facility. NO jumping, speeding, or any other activity Pitt Race may deem dangerous or threatening to other facility users will be permitted.

How can I drive my own car on the track? What equipment do I need?

You can register for one of our Pitt Race driving Programs. These include our Performance Driving Education (PDE), Autocross, or car control programs. For all events you need a helmet, long sleeves, long pants, and close toed shoes. Vehicle requirements vary depending upon the event. Please feel free to visit our website and the downloadable packet for each program under the "Performance Driving" tab and the calendar for program schedules.

How can I use my motorcycle on the track?

While Pitt Race does not conduct any in house motorcycle track days, we do have great partners such as N2 and Evolve GT who schedule track day events throughout the year. Feel free to contact these sanctioning bodies for details on their events.

Do you supply any gear for drivers? Karting?

We have a limited supply of helmets for rent at the Pitt Stop Pro Shop. We do not have a fleet of race cars to rent. For certain Pitt Race events, such as our TVC Car Control Clinic, we do offer the option of using one of our track vehicles in order to reduce wear on customers daily drivers.

For kart rentals, we provide racers with a helmet, neck brace, jacket, and gloves. We recommend that you wear long sleeves and long pants. Closed-toe shoes are required but not provided.

Are concessions available at the track?

Limited concessions are available during the peak season. Lunch is always available and breakfast is available on a limited basis during select events. For special events, catering can be provided through several local vendors. For catering, please contact our office at (724)535-1000.

Can I leave my trailer at the track?

Trailer storage is available for \$25 per month. Those storing trailers on site must also sign a liability waiver and rental agreement. Please contact the main office at (724)535-1000 to make arrangements.

Are garage rentals available?

Kart garages are available for \$125 plus tax per month. These garages are 12'x12'.

Car or motorcycle garages are rented by the day for \$75 plus tax.

Is alcohol permitted at the track?

Alcohol and driving don't mix, so alcoholic beverages are not permitted during track operating hours for any team, driver, or crew member.

If you are a spectator, alcohol may be consumed responsibly and in a safe manner in spectator areas. No open containers are permitted in any paddock at any time during track operation.

Drunkenness, profanity, and/or violence will not be tolerated. Those abusing the rules will be asked to leave immediately. If you are departing our facility after an event, please, for your personal safety and that of you passengers and our community, don't drink and drive.

What about weather?

All Pitt Race events will continue to run in rain. Events may be delayed or postponed due to lightening or extreme weather conditions. Safety is a number one priority at Pitt Race and we will not run events in weather that could be potentially hazardous to customers, employees, or spectators.

Karting rentals and events will be run in rain or shine unless deep water and/or lightening pose danger to participants or equipment.

Are there bleachers available?

Pitt Race has a limited amount of bleachers on Spectator Hill and by Karting. We encourage our guests to bring blankets and canopies to set up to view events. All tents must be appropriately staked down and not in the line of sight of other spectators.

Can I take passengers with me on track during an event?

Passengers are not permitted on any track during any Pitt Race hosted event (excluding instructors). Outside vendors renting the facility may operate under different rules and regulations regarding passengers, however, any track activity over 45 mph, all passengers and drivers must wear an appropriate helmet. Please check with the sanctioning body of any event on their passenger policies.

What is a PDE?

PDE is a Performance Driving Education. This is a course where amateur and experienced drivers get a chance to put their personal cars on track with one of our experienced instructors. Please visit the PittRace.com "Performance Driving" tab for more details.

Does the track run clockwise or counter-clockwise?

All of the tracks at Pitt Race run clockwise. The Wilson Circuit for karting may occasionally be set up to run counter-clockwise for certain events. Due to safety concerns and track design the North, South, and Full tracks cannot be set up for counter-clockwise driving.

How fast do the karts go? How old do you have to be, how tall?

A GX 270cc Honda 4-stroke 9.5 horsepower engine powers the karts. Our rental karts can reach speeds up to 45 mph. For safety reasons the driver must be able to comfortably reach both pedals. To drive an adult rental kart, racers must be at least 5 feet tall. We also have junior karts available with a height requirement of 4 feet. Our junior karts are smaller and have a top speed of 35 mph.
